Two ways to grow retirement savings: Cycle index account investment options (Cycles) and variable separate account investment options (subaccounts).

Cycle highlights:

- 4 index options available.
- No contract fees are assessed while funds are in the Cycles.2
- Cap and participation rates are the same for new and renewing Cycles. Cycle indicative rates are set weekly for Cycles that launch monthly.3
- Cycle performance is determined by an independent third party (S&P Global), and daily unit values can easily be found online at any time.
- Clients can bail out of a Cycle if they want to.4

Clients can protect a portion of their assets through the Cycles.

Clients can customize their allocations to accommodate their investment goals and time frame with both floors and buffers available in 1-, 3-, or 6-year terms.

1-year term:

- -10% buffer
- -30% buffer
- -10% floor

3-year term:

- -10% buffer
- -10% floor

6-year term:

- -10% buffer
- -20% buffer
- -30% buffer
- -10% floor

Cycles launch the third Thursday of each month.

Additional protection option: Your clients can protect their original investment with the Return of Premium (ROP) Death Benefit rider. This rider ensures their beneficiaries receive the greater of premiums paid (adjusted for withdrawals) or the accumulation value.5

- With Anytime Allocation, your clients don't have to wait until a future anniversary date or the end of a term to make adjustments and reallocate their portfolio. They can adjust in real-time with no penalties. Clients cannot reallocate to a Cycle after the Cycle start date (i.e. mid-Cycle). Floor/buffer protections are not applied to any amounts that leave the Cycle early.
- ² Account fees are only assessed on the separate account investment options. Separate account annual expenses include a mortality and expense (M&E) annual fee of 0.80% and asset-based administrative charge annual fee of 0.35%. If an optional rider is elected, those charges can be assessed on the Cycles.
- ³ Indicative rates provide an estimate of what the rate will be for an upcoming Cycle. These rates are not guaranteed and are subject to change. The final rate will be set on the Cycle Start Date.
- ⁴ Bailout feature timeline may vary by state, but it will never be less than 10 business days. In order to exercise the right to bail out of a Cycle, notification must be sent within 10 business days from the date the Cycle confirmation was sent to the Contract Holder.

- 6 If clients leave mid-Cycle, they will get the interim value, which is the Cycle's fair value and may be more or less than the original amount invested in the Cycle. Prior to Cycle maturity date, the floor and buffer rate do not apply. It's generally in the client's best interest to stay in a Cycle until the maturity date. If a client leaves a Cycle mid-term, they cannot enter back into that specific Cycle.
